



# Anticipated Timeline



## Project Overview – Development Agreements

1. Code Based (NMC 17.09) – i.e. Limited in potential scope.

NMC 17.09.030.C. "A development agreement may modify the following development regulations ...only to the extent the applicant can demonstrate the modification ... is necessary to provide flexibility to achieve public benefits and to provide superior outcomes than those that would result from strict compliance with applicable development regulations."

- 2. May only modify specified portions of the code.
- 3. Must provide a Public benefit.



# So what is this project asking for & achieving?

#### • The Public Benefit:

- A neighborhood park on the City's west side with trails and active space
- Park location consistent with Comprehensive Plan at no cost to the City
- Park dedicated to the City / HOA Maintenance of the Park
- Environmental protection and enhancement of wetland and stream
- Trail connection to the 112<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor & City of Renton


#### • The Ask:

- Reduced Setbacks
- Reduced Lot sizes
- Increased impervious surface on each lot (due to reduced lot size)
- Density based on full site area
- Wetland buffer reduction, but improved to exceed existing conditions




### "Neighborhood Park"

- $\sim$  2-5 acres in size
- Serves residents in ~ ½ mile radius
- Passive and active space
- No restrooms or night lighting for evening activities



### "Neighborhood Park"


- Dedication of tracts: A, B, E, F, L, N
- Total approximately: 5-6 Acres of Land Dedicated (13.69 Acres total)
- Tract E: 69,162 SF (1.6 Acres)
- Over ½ mile in trails and pathways
